ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER

Plaintiff, The Project School, by counsel, having filed its Second Motion for Temporary Restraining Order Pending Preliminary Injunction (“Motion”); and

The Court having reviewed the Motion and being duly advised in the premises now finds that Plaintiff will suffer immediate and irreparable injury if Defendants are not enjoined from the actions set forth in the body of this Order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that Defendants show cause before this Court in Marion County, Indiana on the 30th day of July, 2012 at 9:00 a.m. why a preliminary injunction should not issue enjoining Defendants from any and all activities, instructions, communications, or public statements that would have the effect of prohibiting TPS from beginning classes on August 6, 2012 as scheduled and/or promoting the removal of students from TPS enrollment or teachers from TPS staff.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that pending a hearing and determination of Plaintiff’s request for preliminary injunction, Defendants are temporarily

restrained and enjoined from any and all activities, instructions, communications, or public statements that would have the effect of prohibiting TPS from beginning classes on August 6, 2012 as scheduled and/or promoting the removal of students from TPS enrollment or teachers from TPS staff.

This temporary restraining order shall expire at 4:00 ~~a.m.~~/p.m. on August 3, 2012, unless further extended by order of the Court.
