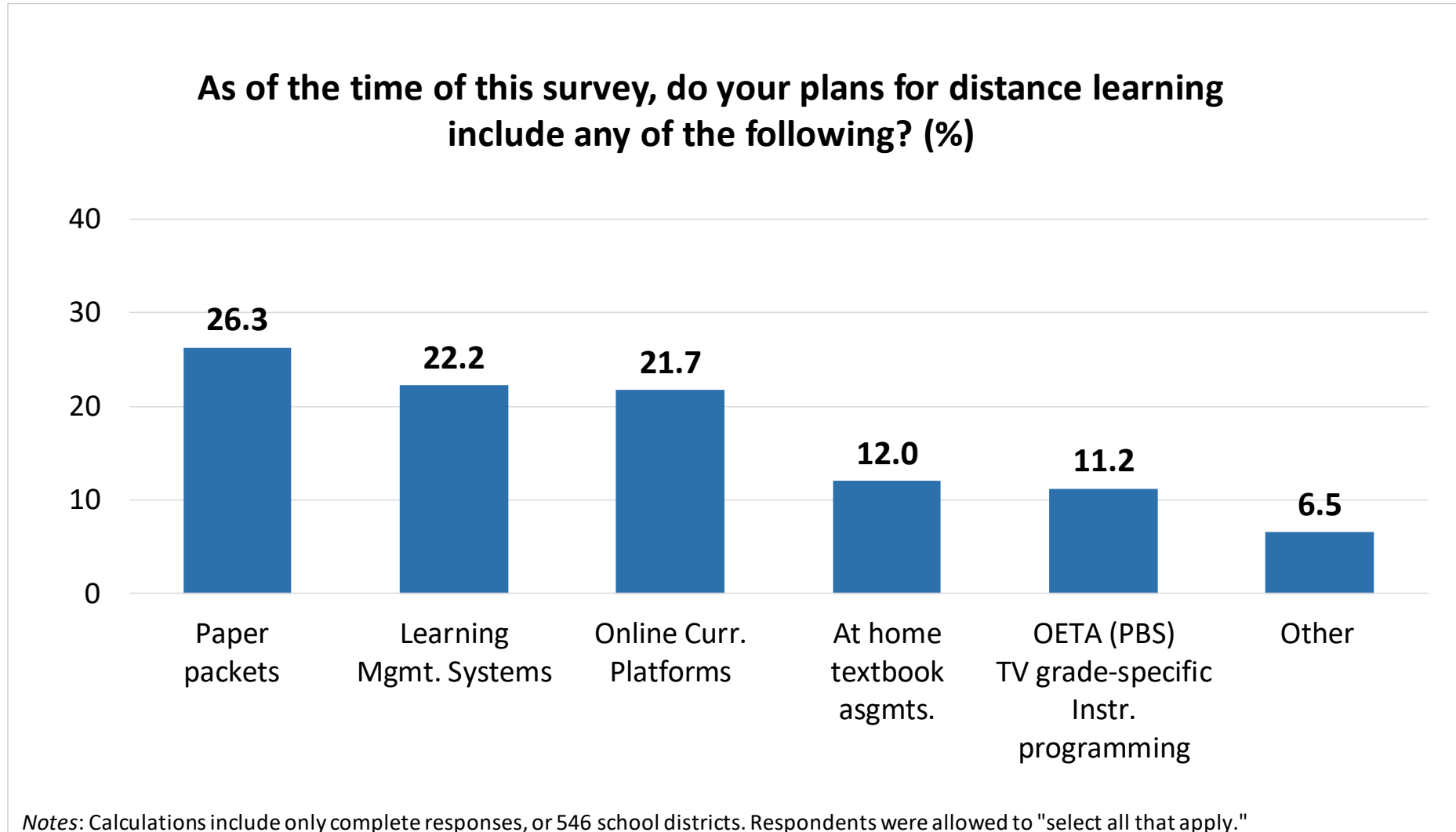

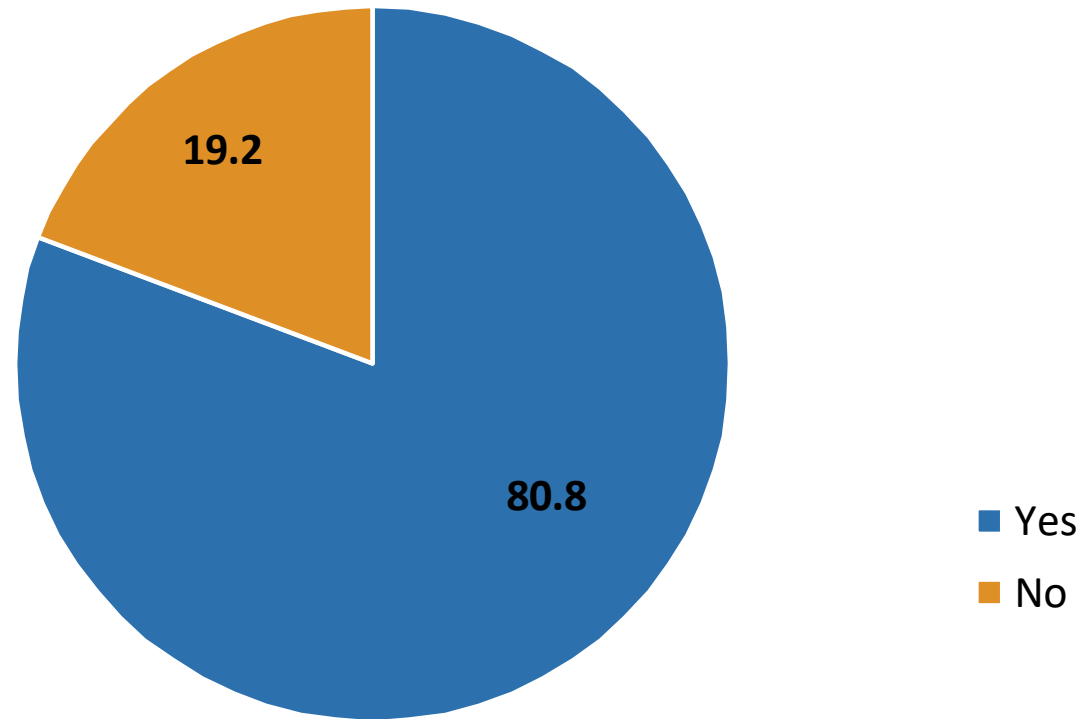

School Districts' Online Learning Capabilities

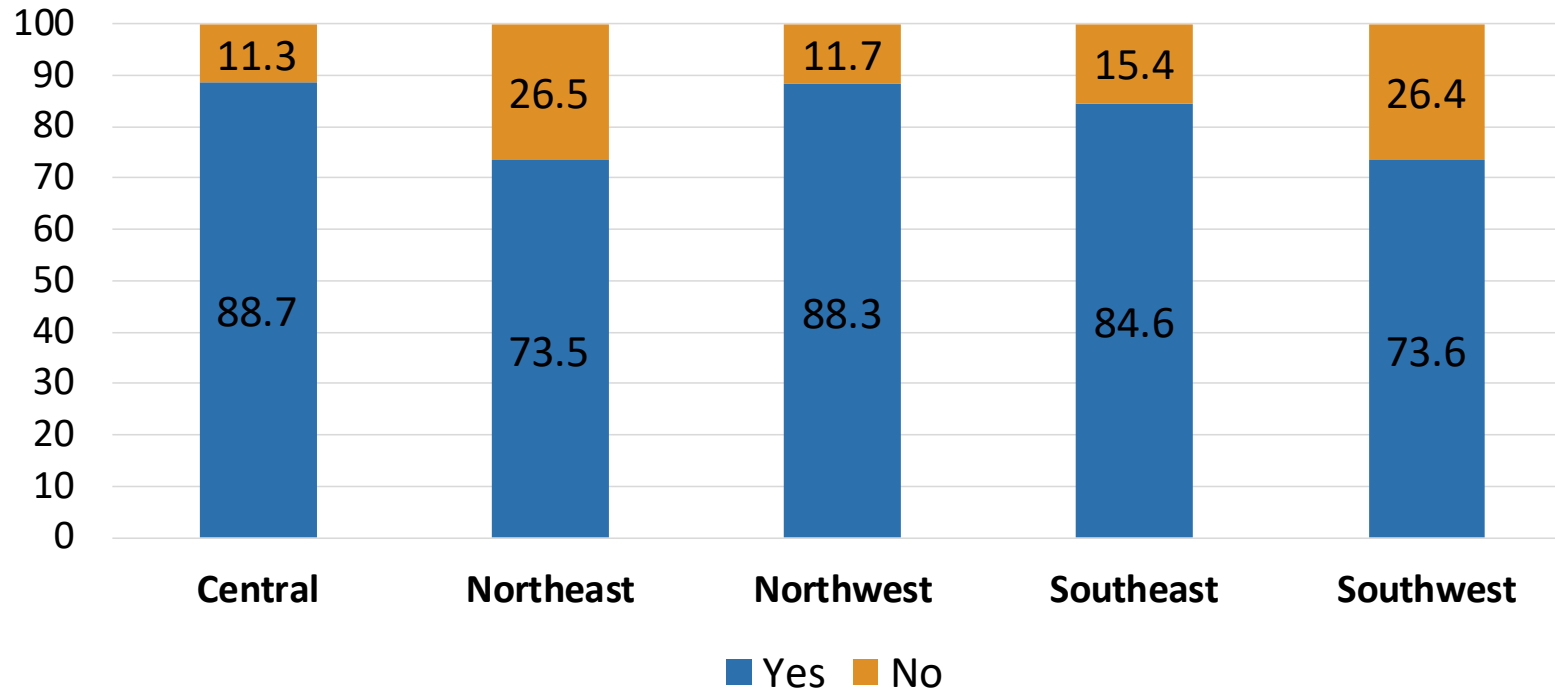
Do you already have online learning platforms or systems that students could use at home if they had an appropriate device (computer or tablet) and Internet service available to them? (%)

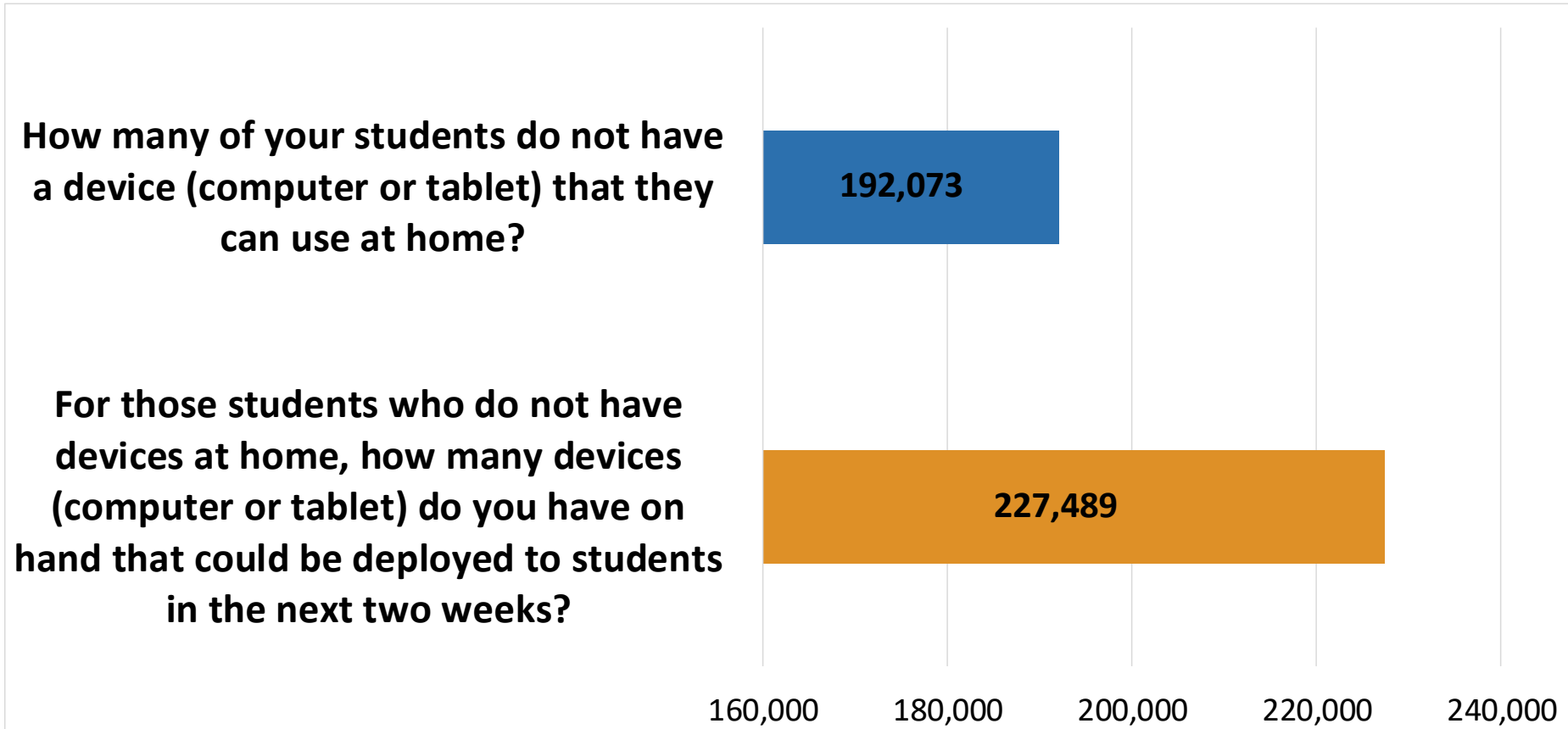

Do you already have online learning platforms or systems that students could use at home if they had an appropriate device (computer or tablet) and Internet service available to them? - Regions (%)



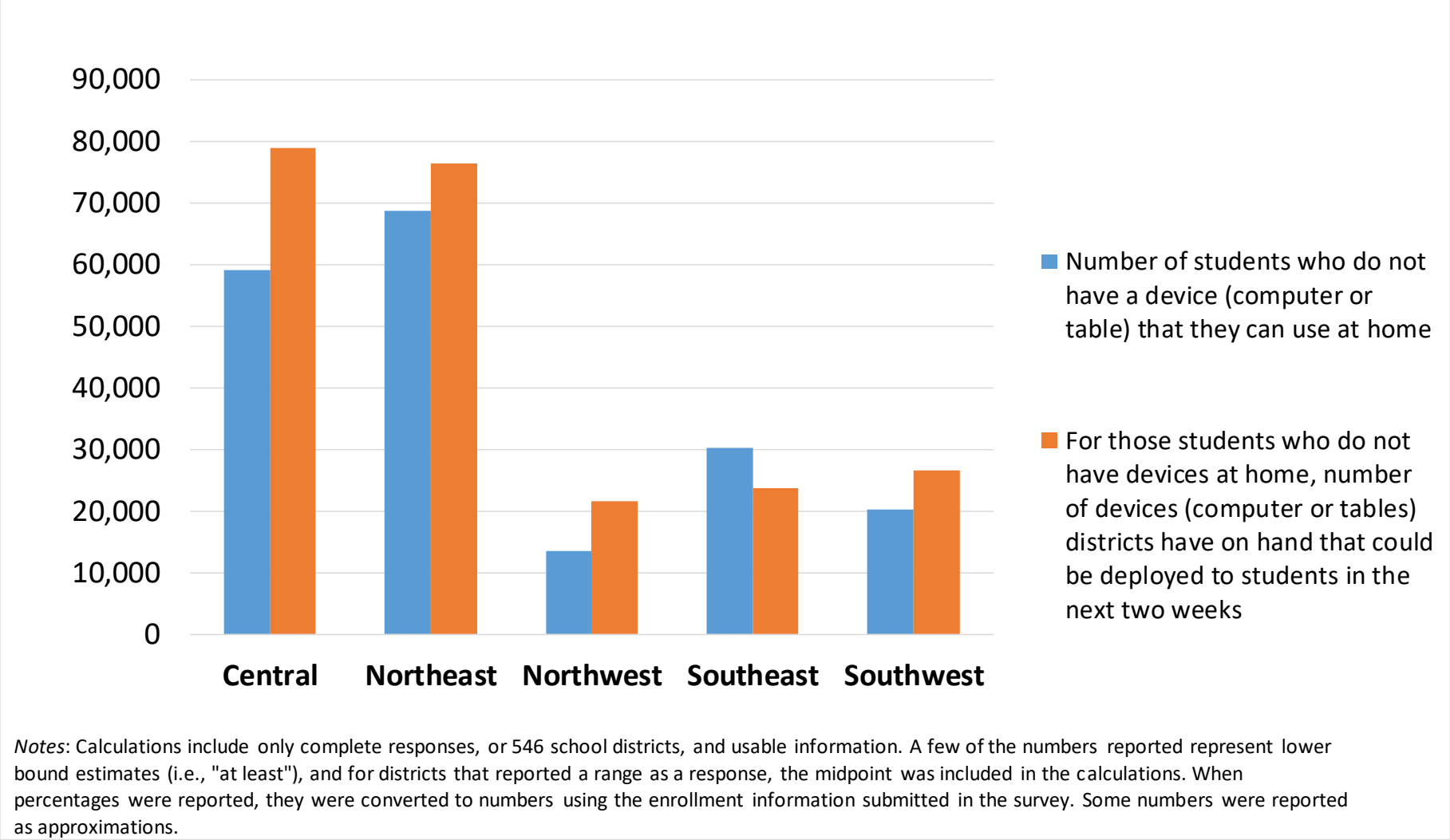

Student/District Devices Availability

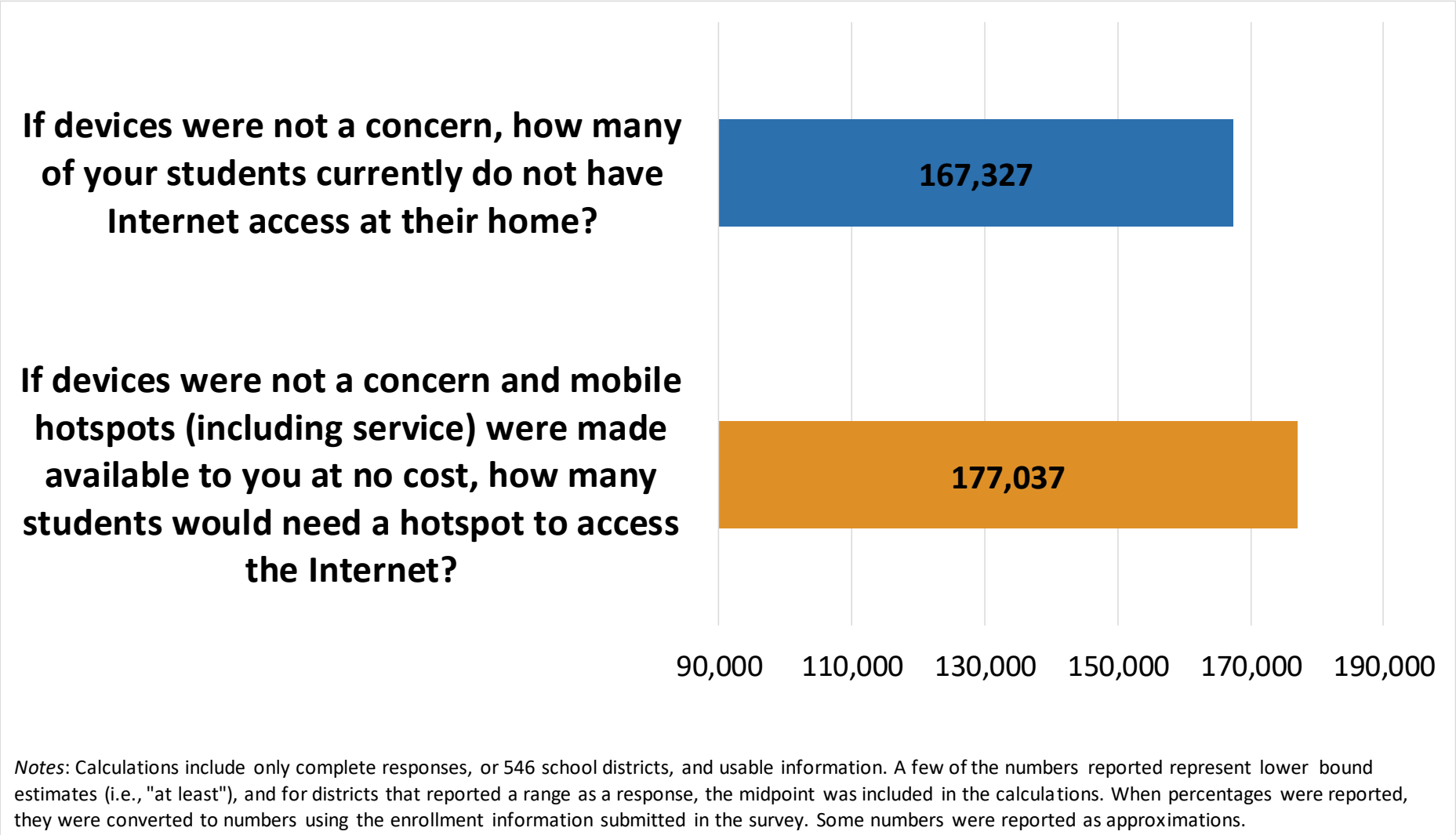

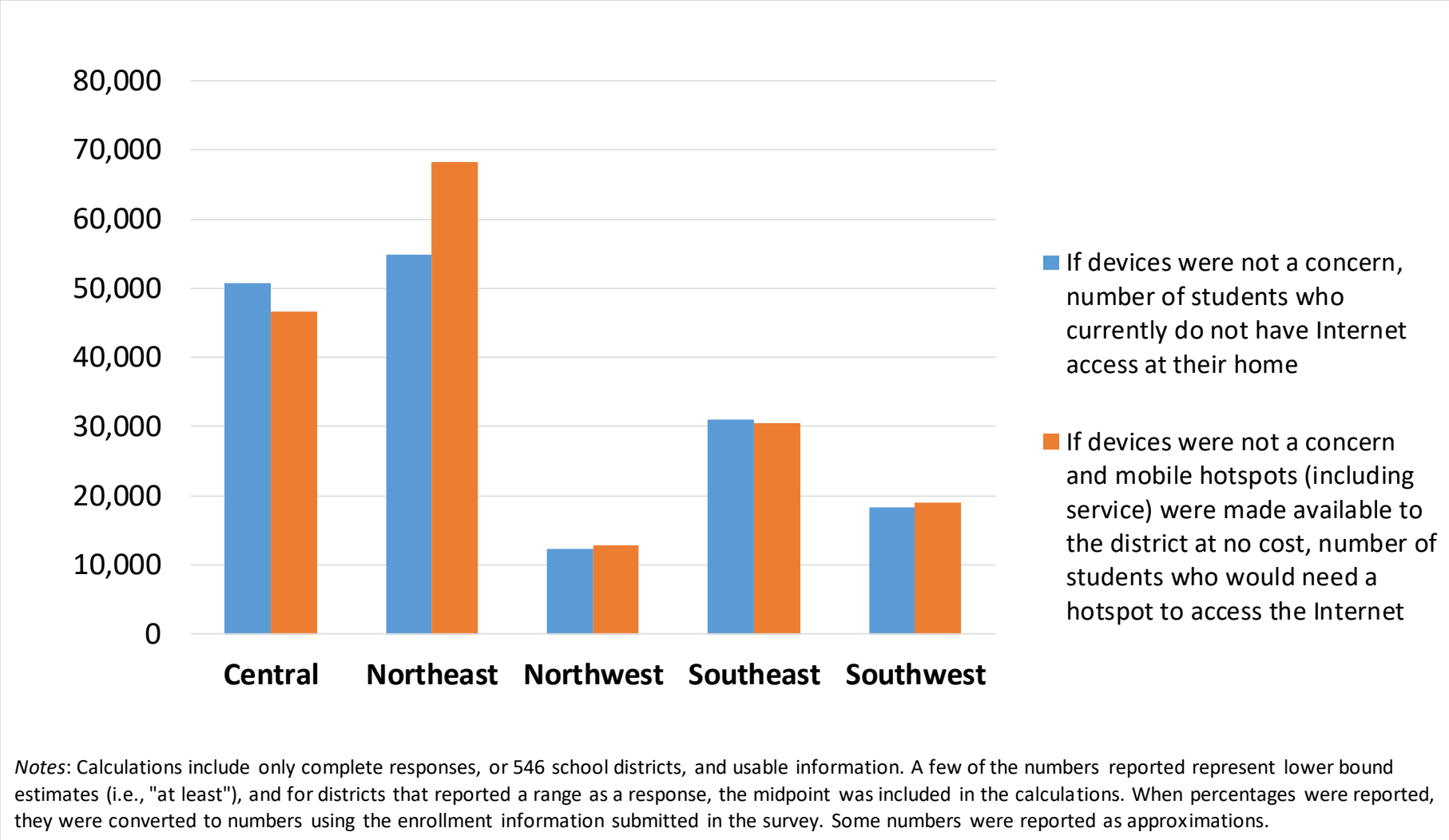

Hotspot/Internet Access Needs

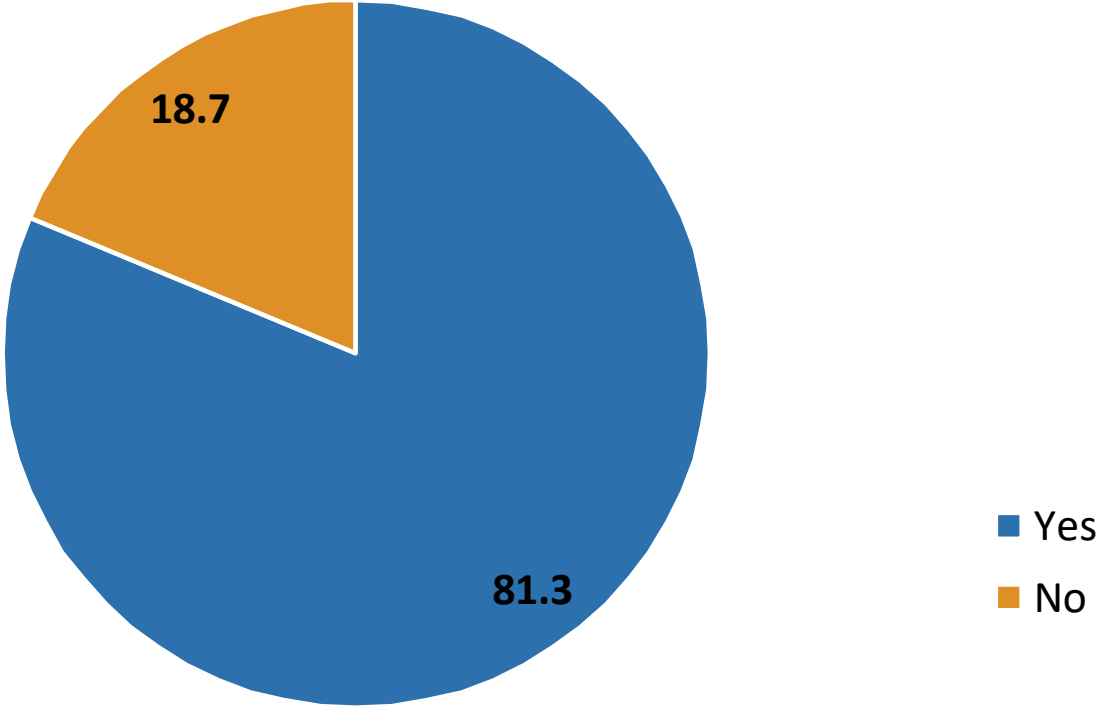

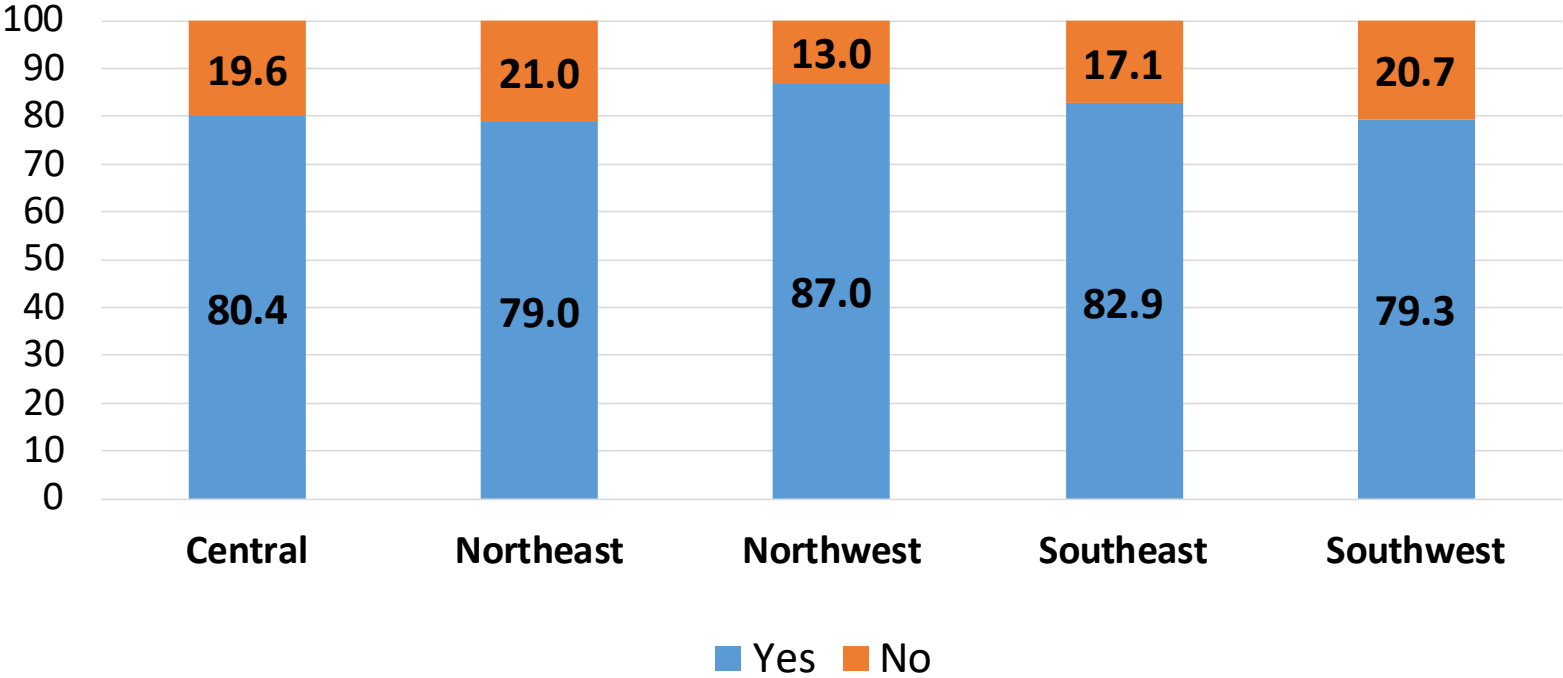
